## Comprehensive Learning Environment

We have also added a part-time nurse to ensure the health and well-being of our students, offering timely medical attention and health awareness programs. Additionally, programs like scout groups and structured extracurricular activities contribute to the overall growth of our students.



## Complete Learning Systems for Early Education

Our pre-primary and primary classes are facilitated by structured programs known as the Complete Preschool System (CPS) and the Complete Primary System (CPrS). These programs ensure that children are taught through a play-way method, integrating age-appropriate topics to encourage curiosity and joy in learning. The CPS and CPrS programs also emphasize academic learning along with holistic evaluation and assessment, fostering balanced intellectual and personal growth in young learners.

The Secondary Education Examination (SEE) results highlighted KBS's commitment to academic excellence. This year, 18 students achieved A+, 34 received A, and 8 secured B+ grades.
