Sponsor Association for Kailash Bodhi School

1. The association is a support association for children who are pupils at Kailash Bodhi School; a school for minority people with Tibetan culture in Nepal and India, established by Lama Gondup in Nepal and in the Indian state of Himachal Pradesh.
2. The members of the association contribute financially to the operation of the schools and salaries for the teachers at the Kailash schools.
3. The association has a leader and a board consisting of a leader, treasurer, secretary and up to four board members, as well as two deputy members.
The leader and the board are elected at the general assembly for 2 years at a time.
The board constitutes itself.
In the case of otherwise equal voting numbers, the leader will have a double vote in board decisions.
4. The leader of the board is responsible for calling board meetings.
5. The leader and the board are responsible for ensuring that the paid-in contributions are forwarded to the children through Karma Chozom at suitable intervals.
6. The leader and the board shall assist in facilitating contact between the schools in Nepal/India and the sponsor parents.
7. The association shall have a meeting at least once a year. Such a meeting may function as the general assembly.
The general assembly is held before the end of the 1st quarter each year.
The notice shall be sent out at least 1 month before the general assembly.
Proposals to be dealt with at the general assembly shall be with the board at least 2 weeks before the general assembly.
A complete agenda shall be sent to the sponsor parents at least 2 weeks before the general assembly.
The general assembly shall contain:
 - Annual report
 - Accounts
 - Elections
 - Incoming matters
 - Any other business
8. Membership in the association ceases when one renounces sponsorship in writing to the association.
9. The minimum contribution is NOK 150 per month, but may be increased according to own wishes.
The contribution is paid in advance every month, preferably with fixed bank transfer.
10. The board has the opportunity to appoint honorary members.
